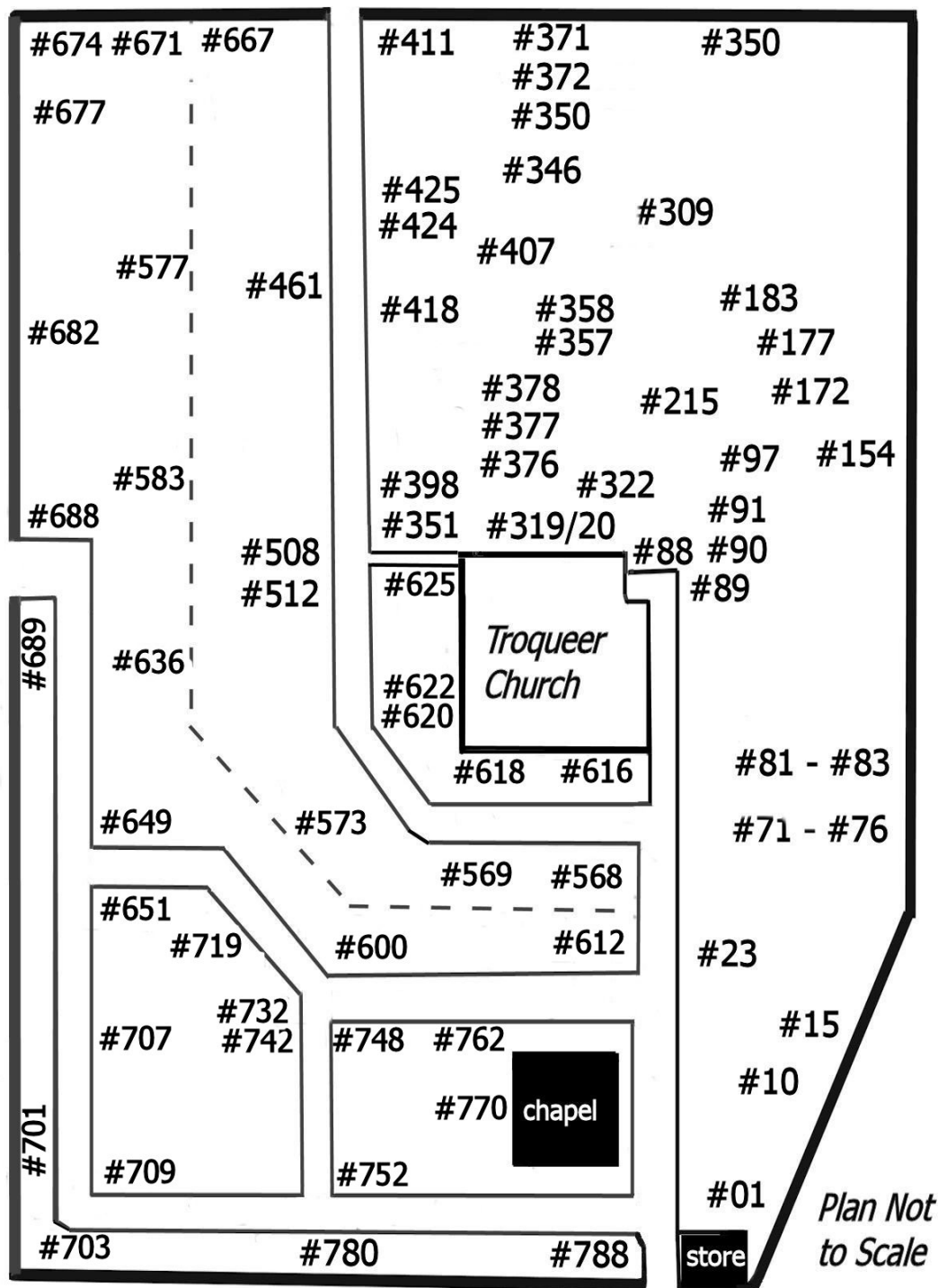

### Acknowledgements

This survey of TROQUEER Memorial Inscriptions follows on from three earlier surveys. The first two were in the 1970s and the third was in the late 1990s. One of the 1970s surveys was carried out by Ewart Library staff, the other was funded by the MSC (Manpower Services Commission) as part of a series of job creation schemes throughout Dumfries and Galloway. Young unemployed persons, supervised by local amateur historians and genealogists, recorded memorial inscriptions from a number of Kirkcudbrightshire graveyards. None of these early surveys were published but copies were deposited in local Libraries.

The more recent survey was undertaken by Alison Mitchell and was published by the Scottish Genealogical Society. Only the MSC survey recorded actual MIs, the others used a summary abbreviated style to record the inscriptions.

In our survey of 2013/14 some stones recorded earlier could not be found and others were no longer fully readable. All MIs were checked, some were corrected and others were added to include more recent burials information.

It is never an easy task to single out the contribution of individuals when many volunteers have contributed large and small to such a project as this.

It will suffice to say that this booklet has come about as a result of the willing cooperation of a large number of volunteers from the Dumfries & Galloway Family History Society who gave their time and skills freely.

Their only reward will be the knowledge that the end product, economically priced, will aid other genealogists and family historians world-wide to further their research.

## Introduction and Historical Notes

The Parish of Troqueer lies within the Stewartry of Kirkcudbright and includes the former Burgh of Maxwelltown. The Parish is bordered on the North by the Parish of Terregles, on the South by New Abbey Parish, on the West by Lochrutton Parish and has the River Nith to the East. The present church stands in an elevated position above the River Nith and is the latest of many churches which have stood on this site.

The Rev John Ewart, writing in 1799, describes the parish as predominately rural in nature and being seven and a half miles long and four and a half miles wide. The River Nith played a significant part in the life of the parishioners providing them with fish as well as sea marl used as a fertiliser. In the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries the Nith was a busy navigable waterway and a significant number of parishioners are shown to have died in foreign parts.

The village of Bridgend which was within the parish lay directly across the Nith from Dumfries and outside the jurisdiction of the Dumfries magistrates. It was regarded as a lawless place in the 18<sup>th</sup> and early 19<sup>th</sup> century.

In 1799 the population of the parish was 2600 with 1302 of those living in Bridgend clustered round Devorgiilla Bridge which linked Troqueer Parish with Dumfries.

The population grew rapidly in the 18<sup>th</sup> century due in part to the building of a new bridge across the Nith, coupled with the establishment of foundries, a waulk mill, a damask manufactory and two nurseries, growing fruit and vegetables for the Dumfries market. The Dumfries Town Mill lay on the Troqueer side of the river, now The Robert Burns Centre. What is now the Dumfries Museum and Camera Obscura was originally a windmill, later converted to an observatory.

As the population grew, Bridgend became a burgh of barony in 1810 named Maxwelltown after Mr Maxwell of Nithsdale, its superior. By 1821 the population of the parish had risen to 4301, 3048 of whom lived in Maxwelltown. Throughout the 19<sup>th</sup> century woollen mills were established in Maxwelltown and the main routes to Edinburgh Glasgow London and Portpatrick passed through the burgh.

The wealthy merchants and entrepreneurs of Dumfries began to move out of the overcrowded and sometimes less than salubrious Dumfries tenements and built grand mansions for themselves in what then was the countryside on the Maxwelltown side of the Nith.

Maxwelltown was joined to Dumfries Burgh under one jurisdiction in 1929. The villas of Summerville, Broomlands, Troqueerholm, Ryedale, Rosefield and Nithside, once the homes of wealthy Dumfries businessmen were developed for housing throughout the 20<sup>th</sup> century and still are named after the estates which once occupied their sites.

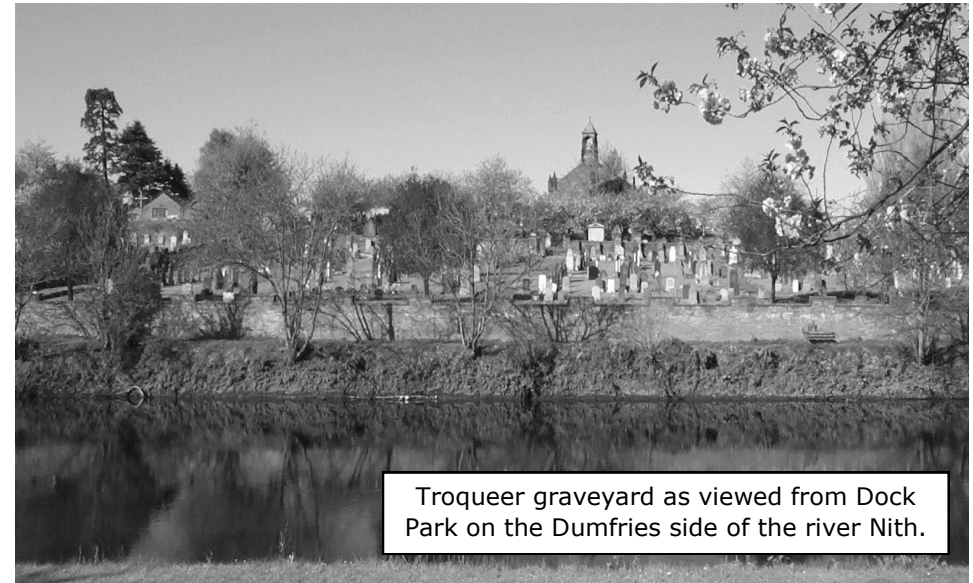
The headstones in Troqueer Churchyard bear testimony to the varied and interesting lives of the inhabitants of the parish long gone.

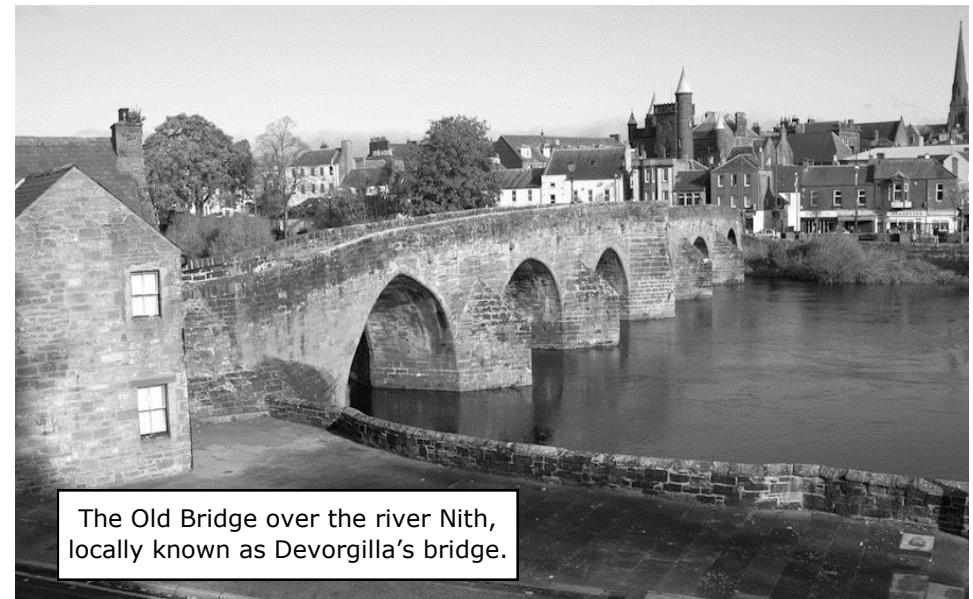

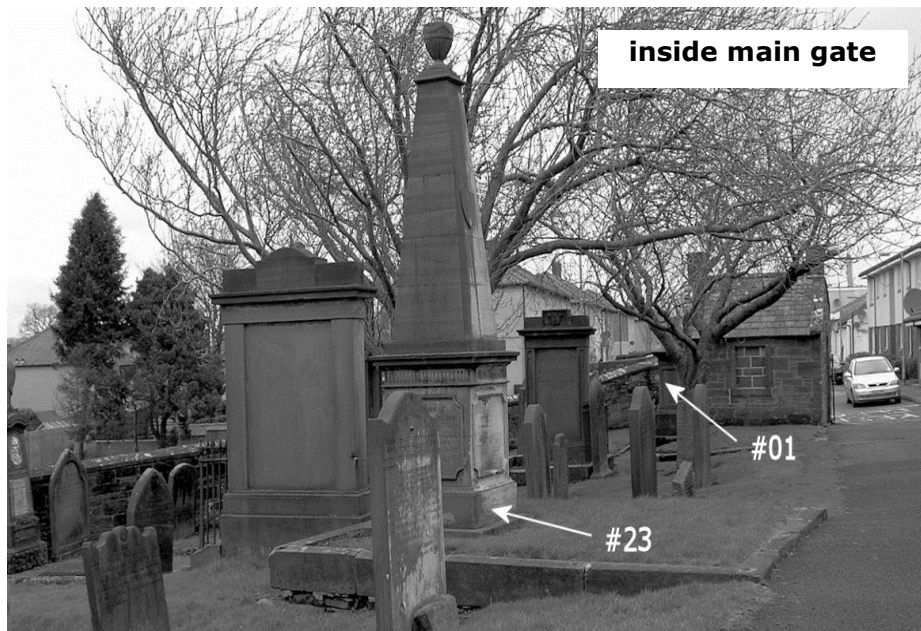
Troqueer graveyard as viewed from Dock Park on the Dumfries side of the river Nith.

## Inscriptions - MIs 01 to 400

- 01 [a square pedestal inside front gate - inscription on all four sides] Sacred to the memory of Anne MCKENZIE wife of Rev William THORBURN who died 23rd Sept 1840 aged 68. Sacred to the memory of Rev William THORBURN who died 3rd April 1846 in the 79th year of his age and 54th year of his ministry having been for nine years minister of the Parish of Girthon and forty five years Minister of the Parish of Troqueer. Sacred to the memory of John Francis son of David Thorburn M.D. born Dec 20th 1833 died Feby 22nd 1835 and of second son of the same name born Feb 6th 1836 died 21st Feb 1838 *of such is the Kingdom of Heaven* In memory of Mariane Thorburn who was born 13th Sept 1794 and died 15th May 1811 and of William THORBURN who died the 2nd October 1815 aged 17 years. *A young man remarkable for his literary acquirements.* Also Liliast STAIG THORBURN third daughter of the Rev Wm THORBURN who died in Sept 1846 aged 45 years. In Memory of Georgina MACKENZIE Thorburn who was born the 3rd day April 1801 and died the 4th June 1807. Sacred to the memory of Georgina Mackenzie Thorburn sixth daughter of the Rev WILLIAM THORBURN who died 14th Janry 1846 in her 35th year Sacred to the memory of Kenneth Mackenzie THORBURN WS Esquire of Moat who died on the 17th June 1852 in the 45th year of his age Also Nancy THORBURN second daughter of the Rev William THORBURN who died the 13th March 1861
- 02 In Memory of John FORSYTH who died on the 29th September 1832 aged 32 years. Also Ann MOODIE wife of John FORSYTH junior who died 15th July 1878 aged 54 years. And the said John FORSYTH who died 27th Nov 1884 aged 61 years.





- 03 In Memory of Mary CROCKET wife of John MAXWELL Maxwelltown who died 13th Dec 1848 aged 57 years. Also Mary MAXWELL their daughter who died 12th Dec 1848 aged 13 years. Also the above John MAXWELL who died at Maxwelltown March 28th 1866 aged 84 years. Also Elizabeth AFFLECK wife of James MAXWELL farmer Starryhaugh who died 20th January 1856 aged 26 years. Also the said James MAXWELL who died at Maxwelltown 1st May 1874 aged 53 years. Also William SCOTT grandson OF the above John MAXWELL who died at CORBERRY PLACE 13TH nov 1915 aged 72 years. also Jane SKEOCH wife of the above William SCOTT who died 16th August 1924 aged 79 years.
- 04 In Memory of Thomas DALRYMPLE son of William DALRYMPLE flesher in Maxwelltown who died 20th Feb 1809 aged 11 months. Also Margaret JARDINE spouse to the said William DALRYMPLE who died 16th March 1813 aged 28 years. Also Margaret DALRYMPLE who died 22nd Sep 1814 aged 4 years and 9 months. Also Catherine DALRYMPLE who died 10th May 1815 aged 3 years and 4 months. Also Jane DALRYMPLE who died 26th October 1833 aged 25 years and is interred in the Calton Churchyard Edinburgh. Also Catherine daughter of William DOCHERTY his nephew who died 9th October 1848 aged 9 months. Also Jean his daughter who died 7th March 1851 aged 5 years and 11 months. Sacred to the memory of William DOCHERTY flesher in Maxwelltown who died on the 28th September 1876 aged 65 years. And Elizabeth CRAIG his wife who died at Glasgow 15th February 1882 aged 74 years. Also Margaret DOCHERTY daughter of the above who died on the 17th May 1866 aged 25 years.
- 05 Sacred to the memory of James M S C GOLDIE son of Thomas GOLDIE farmer at Priestlands who died on the 9th June 1845 aged 21 years. Also Thomas GOLDIE his son who died on 21st September 1847 aged 21 years. And of John THOM who died at Goshen Jamaica on the 1st December 1847 aged 37 years. Also Janet COWAN wife of Thomas GOLDIE who died at Maryholm Cottage 18th November 1854 aged 65 years. And John THOM her grandson who died at Maxwelltown 1st September 1855 aged 12 years. Also the above Thomas GOLDIE who died 21st July 1860 aged 68 years.
- 06 In Memory of Ketrone JOHNSTON spouse to Thomas BELL joiner in Maxwelltown who died the 3rd of February 1818 aged 39 years. Also Mary William and James BELL their children who died in their infancy. Also Francis COMBE who died at 67 Glasgow Street Maxwelltown on 21st February 1907 aged 57 years.
- 07 In loving memory of James MCQUHAE tailor who died in Maxwelltown 14th July 1893 aged 62 years. Also Henrietta WILSON widow of the above who died at Alberta Canada 22nd July 1914 aged 79 years. Also Elizabeth CROCKET his daughter who died in Maxwelltown 1st March 1875 aged 5 years and was interred in St Michael's churchyard. Also Henrietta WILSON his daughter who died at Maxwelltown 17th May 1899 aged 24 years. Also Agnes eldest daughter of the above who died in Manchester 24th Jany 1920 aged 59 years.
- 08 In memory of Robert HETHERINGTON who died 28th March 1844 aged 76. Also of Ann his wife who died 3rd January 1834 aged 68. Their honesty industry and integrity were known to man. Their faith hope and love were known to God. Their spirits have returned to God who gave them. Their bodies rest here waiting



the coming of the Lord. Also William HETHERINGTON KIRKPATRICK their grandson who died 29th July 1841 aged 7 years. Erected by their son the Rev W M HETHERINGTON LLD [stone has fallen]

- 09 In memory of William DRUMMOND son of James DRUMMOND tanner in Dumfries who died the 23rd day of March 1810 aged 22 months and 13 days. Also Mary HEUCHAN spouse to the said James DRUMMOND tanner who died 13th February 1823 aged 56 years. Also William DRUMMOND their son who died 27th of July 1823 aged 12 years. Also James DRUMMOND their son who died 1st October 1825 aged 22 years. Also John DRUMMOND their son who died 30th November 1831 aged 39 years. Also Sarah DRUMMOND their daughter who died 8th of May 1832 aged 37 years. Also the above James DRUMMOND tanner who died on the 6th day of April 1834 aged 69 years.



- 10 Sacred to the memory of James HALLIDAY of Greenbrae formerly of Carruchan who died on the 24th day of April 1848 in the 82nd year of his age. Also Elizabeth MONTGOMERY his wife who died on the 21st June 1830 aged 52 years. Also Elizabeth their daughter who died on the 5th January 1824 aged 13 years. Also John their son who died 28th January 1824 aged 17 years. Also of Isabel HALLIDAY aunt of the said James HALLIDAY who died on the 10th of March 1814 aged 82 years. [flat stone in the same enclosure] In memory of Elizabeth daughter of James HALLIDAY formerly in Carruchan who died 5th January 1824 aged 13 years. 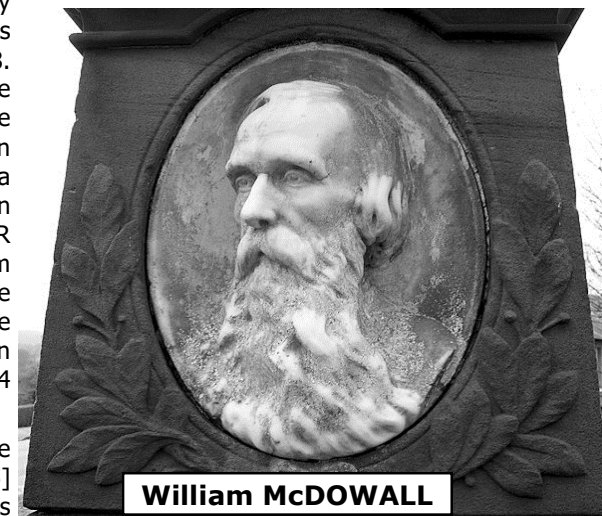

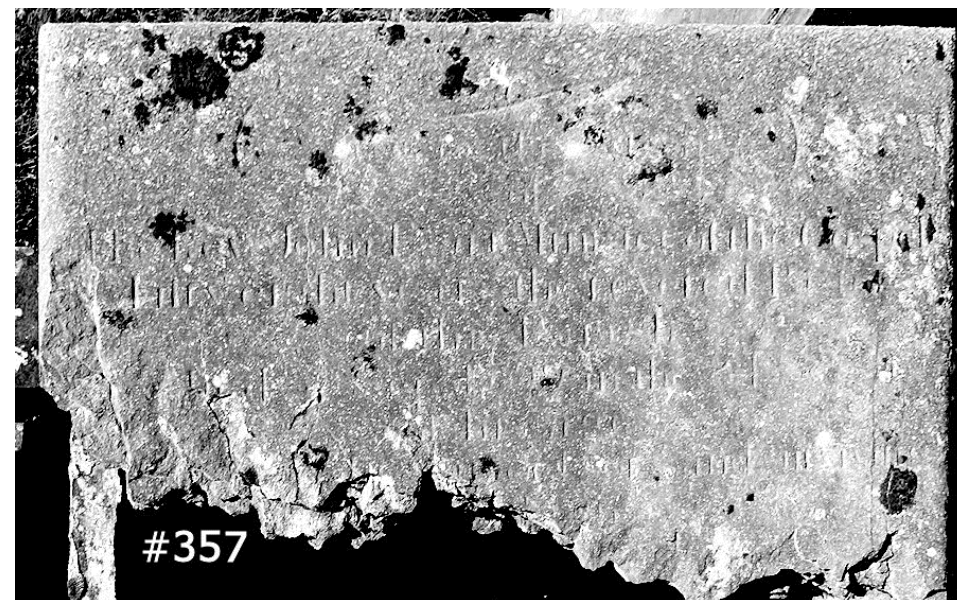
